



HOW TO FILL OUT YOUR ROOTED & BUILT COMMITMENT CARD

Thank you for prayerfully considering your commitment to Rooted & Built. Please use these simple steps to complete your Commitment Card:

1. Complete Your Information

Fill in your name, address, email, and phone number. Don't assume the church has all of your information.

2. Launch Gift

If you are able, indicate a one-time Launch Gift to be given by the end of 2026. A Launch Gift provides important funds upfront and helps reduce the amount the church may need to borrow.

3. Three-Year Commitment

Choose how you would like to give—weekly, monthly, or annually. Check the appropriate box and enter your gift amount.

4. Gifts of Assets

You may also choose to contribute stocks, property, charitable donations, or other assets. Please include the estimated value and a brief description.

5. Total Your Commitment

Add together all of the areas that you assigned a dollar amount to and enter the total in the square box at the bottom of the card.
