Shared Values and Beliefs

- We believe Jesus Christ is our Savior and Lord. He teaches us to live the abundant life-- full of joy as we worship the risen Christ and serve other people to the glory of God.
- We believe the Bible is the Word of God. Scripture reveals God's
 plan for salvation through Jesus Christ. It teaches us how to live,

 interpreter of scriptures we need no other mediator between us
 and God. We strive to deepen our relationship with God and our
 understanding of God's purpose for us through prayer, bible study,
 and wise counsel.
- We believe Baptism and The Lord's Supper are symbolic celebrations of grace. Believer's Baptism is an outward expression celebrating new life in Christ. The Lord's Supper celebrates God's grace for humanity by Christ's last supper with His disciples and sacrificial death on the Cross. These ordinances serve as witness of our faith in Christ.
- We believe the Church is the body of Christ on Earth. We are a community of believers, not a building or institution. Our congregation is autonomous, yet part of the larger body of Christ. Believers achieve oneness in Christ that transcends all human limitations, including the diversity between denominations.
- We believe in the Priesthood of all Believers. We ordain both men and women for every role of service in the church.

This occurs as we engage in a balance of worship, mission endeavors, personal spiritual formation, and community connections with other people. We believe the culture of our church allows people to participate in each of these aspects.
